“FREE FOR ALL!”
DIRECTOR JOHN WELLINGTON ENNIS
REVEALS ELECTION FRAUD EVIDENCE WHILE AT
DEMOCRATIC NATIONAL CONVENTION

— Political Doc Coming to DVD on October 7, 2008—

LOS ANGELES (August 29, 2008)—Filmmaker and citizen journalist **John Wellington Ennis’ Shoot First Inc.** (www.shootfirstinc.com) presents the call-to-action political documentary **“FREE FOR ALL!”** on DVD this October 7, 2008. Ennis presented the film’s evidence on U.S. Election fraud at the **Progressive Democrats of America (PDA)** headquarters in Denver, Colorado, during the **Democratic National Convention**, from Sunday, August 24 – 28, 2008. **“FREE FOR ALL!”** began streaming online for free at www.freeforall.tv on July 4, 2008.

Information that comes to light in *FREE FOR ALL!* includes evidence of rigged recounts, uncounted provisional ballots in swing states, systematic purging or “caging” of voters, strategic intimidation and intentional misinformation.

Other stars of **“FREE FOR ALL!”** also appeared at the PDA headquarters: **Greg Palast** spoke regarding media and election reform, while **Brad Friedman** addressed “Clean, Fair and Transparent Elections” at a forum sponsored by **The Nation** magazine.

Using satire, comedy and animation, the feature-length documentary explores the concept of truth itself, questioning what we often take for granted as the basis for facts. Ennis has pieced together an incredible jigsaw puzzle of fraudulent U.S. Election schemes, utilizing knowledge from his friends—like award-winning investigative journalist Greg Palast, politician turned talk show host **Jerry Springer**, NYU media studies professor **Mark Crispin Miller** and election integrity journalist Brad Friedman of **BradBlog.com**, among others.

Ennis comments, “Based on the information I gathered during the 2006 elections in Ohio, I am convinced that high voter turnout is one way to defeat voter suppression tactics that will be running rampant during the 2008 U.S. Presidential Election. Voter I.D. obstacles are just one specific tactic that could potentially disenfranchise millions of urban city dwellers in November. It is vital that Americans have a photo I.D. with a current address to vote. Avoiding provisional ballots is a must, as they don’t always get counted.”

The *FREE FOR ALL!* DVD with Extras is available for purchase on the website for \$20.08. Extras and bonus footage includes a short film on Ohio’s former Secretary of State **Ken Blackwell**. The DVD also features Spanish subtitles and English closed-captioning.
